
Mayor Darren Braddy called the public hearing to order. Mayor Braddy stated that this public hearing was to discuss the burned structure located at 831 E. Kaufman. This property is where SPCA became involved and confiscated multiple cats which had been left in this structure unattended. The structure was highly contaminated with feces and considered a health hazard. Shortly after the SPCA removed the cats, the house caught on fire and partially burned, which left the structure in a dilapidated and health hazard state. Mayor Braddy stated that the official procedure documents were presented to the owner in person. The owner was not present at the public hearing. Mayor Braddy stated that the city could not do anything until the State Fire Marshall and insurance company were finished with their investigations. Mayor Braddy asked the public for input. There was no response.


