

ORDINANCE NO. 03-01-91

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COOPER, COOPER, TEXAS, TO PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF GAME CHICKENS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COOPER; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COOPER, TEXAS:

SECTION I:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Cooper to adopt, in all respects, a prohibition against the keeping of game chickens within the City limits of the City of Cooper; and

It shall be unlawful for any person to harbor, keep, or bring any game chicken within the corporate limits of the City of Cooper.

The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be a fine not to exceed \$200.00 per day.

SECTION II:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION III:

If any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION IV:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval and following its second reading.

SECTION V:

An emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public. Therefore, all rules and regulations providing for the reading of ordinances on more than one occasion be, and the same are, hereby suspended, and this ordinance is passed and shall take effect as an emergency measure, and shall be and remain in full force and effect as herein provided from and after its passage and approval.

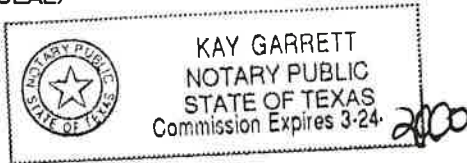

ORDINANCE NO. 020697

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COOPER, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR RELEASE OF ANY STRAYS FROM CAPTIVITY BY CITY PERSONELL; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COOPER HAS DETERMINED THAT A FEE OF \$25.00 SHOULD BE IMPOSED FOR THE RELEASE OF ANY STRAYS HELD IN CAPTIVITY BY THE CITY; SUCH FEE BEING TO DEFRAY THE COST OF CAPTURE AND HOLDING;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COOPER, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. ANY PERSON DESIRING THE RELEASE OF ANY ANIMAL BEING HELD AS A STRAY BY THE CITY MAY OBTAIN THE RELEASE OF SUCH ANIMAL UPON PAYMENT OF A FEE OF \$25.00 TO THE CITY OF COOPER. SUCH PAYMENT MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO THE TRANSFER OF THE ANIMAL TO FINAL DISPOSITION FACILITIES. UPON RECEIPT OF SUCH FEE THE CITY PERSONNEL HOLDING THE ANIMAL SHALL RELEASE THE ANIMAL (EXCEPT IN CASES OF SUSPECTED RABIES OR OTHER PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY ISSUES).

SECTION 2. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AS THE LAW AND CHARTER IN SUCH CASE PROVIDES.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SO ORDAINED.
